Around 500 swans were sighted in the area between March 4th and 8th, though no swans landed in the wildlife area. Swans landed on March 9th, and volunteers noted the presence of trumpeter swans and ducks. Volunteers spotted meadowlarks on March 20th. Feeding and counting concluded on March 29th.

Around 30 swans were sighted in the area between March 1st and 4th, though no swans landed in the wildlife area. Swans landed on March 4th. Volunteers spotted ducks such as pintails, mallards, and mergansers on March 6th. Snow geese were present on March 18th. Visitors also noted an injured swan outside of the fenced area on March 18th, and the Stewardship Council was able to help the swan rejoin the bevy to recover. Feeding and counting concluded on March 27th.
